

GENERAL OVERVIEW

Nis is the **3rd largest city** in Serbia and financial, educational, industrial, commercial, administrative and cultural center of Southern and Eastern Serbia Region.

The position of Nis is **strategically important**, at the intersection of European highway and railway networks connecting Europe with Asia.

As such it is the regional **center for 2 million inhabitants** (according to the last estimations) and it is in constant focus of the development strategy of the Government of the Republic of Serbia.

Many important infrastructure and other investment projects were initiated/finished during the last years: Corridor X highway, Clinical Center Nis, Nis Airport Development etc.

Resently, many foreign investors have chosen Nis as their investment location: Integrated Micro Electronics, Zumtobel, Leoni, Aster Textile, while others such as Johnsons are constantly expanding their business.

The Government of Serbia will continue with the development strategy for Nis, especially in terms of developing **Nis as engineering, technological and manufacturing hub of South Serbia.**

- Nis offers all the advantages of modern city and at the same time is surrounded by the amazing landscape and scenery.
- Among other things Niška Banja, Sićevo gorge and Suva mountain are just some of the must-visit and must-see natural attractions.
- As one of the oldest cities in Europe, Nis is famous for its historical and archaeological treasures such as Nis fortress, Skull Tower, Mediana etc, as it was the birthplace of the Roman emperor Constantine the Great, one of the key figures in the history of Europe and Christianity.
- Along with historical monuments and attractions, Nis offers dynamic everyday life with numerous festivals, cultural and sport events such are: Nisville Jazz Festival, Film festival, International Choral Festival, etc.



- In order to foster spa and medical tourism development, the Government of Serbia financially supports spa notel investments.
- Niška Banja is one of the best known centers of health tourism in Serbia and it is the third most popular spa in Serbia after Vrnjačka Banja and Sokobanja.
- There are 5 springs of healing water and natural mud. It is well known for its hot spring water.
- There are several hotels without enough beds and many private accommodation available.
- Niška Banja is thought to heal coronary and blood vessels diseases, increased blood pressure and rheumatic disorders. It is also famous for the treatment of orthopedic injuries, body weight control, anti-cellulite treatments and postoperative rehabilitation.







CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF NIS

International highway corridor X

- Works on the southern and eastern arms of the Corridor 10 were completed in 2019 and the Corridor 10 through the Republic of Serbia is now in use.
- The corridor connects the City of Nis with the Republic of Bulgaria to the east and further to east to the City of Istanbul.
- In the south, the corridor leads to the Republic of Northern Macedonia and continues to Thessaloniki and Athens.
- During 2021, the construction of the highway from Niš to Pristina began, the section through Serbia to <u>Pločnik</u> in the length of 38km.

Investment value of the first phase is € 220mil.

Science Technology Park project

- Phase 1 Student center for innovative entrepreneurship started working on September 6, 2017.

- Phase 3 Building and creation of the Science Technology Park started working on September 1, 2020.



Nis has an excellent and important strategic position- it is a major European crossroads connecting southern arms of Corridor 10-leading to Greece and eastern towards Bulgaria and to Turkey and the Middle East



CONNECTIVITY, STRATEGIC POSITION OF THE CITY

Nis Airport – 2nd fastest growing airport in Europe by the number of passengers in 2017

- International Airport Constantine the Great is the second largest airport (passenger and cargo) in Serbia.
- The expansion began in 2015 when low-cost airlines Wizz Air and Ryanair launched their first flights.
- After these events airport experienced triple-digit growth in passenger traffic, exceeding the previous record figure.
- Airport in Nis will continue to develop, and the Government adopted the decision of establishing new destinations of public interest.
- Today, due to the situation related to the global Covid 19 pandemic, a total of 17 flights from the airport of Constantine the Great are active.










INDUSTRIAL HERITAGE, AND TODAY'S INDUSTRY

The city of Niš has a long history of industrial production of electronics and mechatronics, which has been expanding in recent years







- Before WWII the local economy started developing through textile, machine and tobacco industry.
- In the period between 1960—1990 economy started blooming companies such as Electronic Industry, Tobacco Industry, Machine Industry, Nitex, Vulkan, Nis brewery, Bank of Nis, etc. grew into the economic giants and in 1981 GDP per capita was at 110% of Yugoslavia average.
- Since the beginning of the political turmoils, breakup of Yugoslavia and sanctions, Nis economy started deteriorating- production halved, many people lost their jobs, etc. Within the last 15 years Nis has stared to regain its former industrial glory.

In addition to the electronics and mechatronics industry, the market is increasingly dominated by IT companies that carry out new directions and dynamics of city development




Research and Development-Higher education in Nis







The economic development of the city directly affects the reduction of the number of unemployed persons




The economic development of the city directly affects the increase of the number of employed persons

REVIEW OF AVERAGE NET SALARY (EUR)




